

Statement of Services, Date 03/22/08.

Contractor shall perform the following services:

1. Provide continuing education and testing over the Internet including customized educational lessons, testing and certification on the Internet for professionals that have recurring certification and / or testing requirements to work. The educational services Contractor shall provide on the Internet are historically offered through correspondence courses, company or university classes and commercial seminars.
2. Contractor shall (1) provide or (2) receive and convert course material and post it on the Internet along with the corresponding quiz. If the Contractor provides the course materials then Amtrak's representatives shall (a) review all materials in their final form, (b) approve in writing and (c) assume all liabilities for same.
3. Company employees may read the lessons and take the quizzes on-line.
4. Contractor shall electronically grade the quiz and issue a report to the company management so that a certificate can be issued to those that pass and retest those that fail.
5. Contractor shall charge for processing the quiz and issuing the report to the company management so that Company can issue any certificate required to maintain Company employee's approval, license or certification to practice their profession.
6. Amtrak is exempt from taxes in the same manner as the U.S. Government.
 - 6a. Contractor shall not charge sales taxes for providing continuing education and testing.
 - 6b. Contractor shall not charge sales taxes for charges by the Contractor as the Internet Service Provider for (1) maintaining the WEB pages or (2) any separate charges for processing students data that is subject to sales tax as data processing services.
7. Contractor shall not charge for preparing any (a) received or (b) converted course material, and posting it on the Internet along with the corresponding quiz, if the material is released by Amtrak as a "shared" item for Contractor's free, unlimited use and reuse with other of the Contractor's customers.

Note 2: Multiple colored balls of the same color within any particular Subject Title are counted as 1 for Pricing Schedule calculations.
